1. INTRODUCTION

- 1.2. This page sets out the cookie policy of Mega Fortris (Europe) ApS Ltd. ("we", "us" and "our") and explains how we use cookies on our website (megafortris.eu) (the "Website").
- 1.3. We use cookies on our website, which amongst other things, help us to improve your experience of the Website and to ensure that it performs as you expect it to.
- 1.4. A cookie is a small file of letters and numbers, which are transferred to your computer's hard drive or mobile device when you visit the Website. The cookies are then sent back to the originating website on each subsequent visit or to another website that recognises that cookie. They can improve your experience of using a website, for example, by remembering your preference settings and tracking your use of a website so that it can be improved to meet your needs. They can also help to ensure that adverts you see online are more relevant to you and your interests.
- 1.5. We may amend our cookie policy at any time and we will notify you of any change by revising the date at the bottom of this Cookies Policy. The changes will take effect once they have been posted on the Website. Therefore, you should review these terms on a regular basis.

2. HOW WE USE COOKIES

- 2.1. Websites must get consent to send cookies to your computer or mobile device unless the cookies are strictly necessary to provide services to you. You can set your cookie preferences when you arrive at the Website, or change them at any time [by clicking here]. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies as soon as you visit the Website.
- 2.2. Unless the cookie is strictly necessary, you can withdraw your consent to our cookies at any time even if you have previously consented. Although, please do remember that if you do not consent to our functionality cookies, parts of the Website may not work. For this reason we will occasionally send you prompts which allow you to consent to a cookie you have previously rejected.
- 2.3. We may collect information about your computer, including your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration purposes. This is statistical data about our users' browsing actions and patterns and does not identify you as an individual. If you agree, we may obtain information about your general internet usage by using a cookie file. The Website uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of the Website. This helps us to deliver a better and more personalised service to you when you browse the Website and also allows us to improve the Website.

3. TYPES OF COOKIES USED ON THE WEBSITE

- 3.1. The tables below explain what cookies we use on our Website, why we use them and whether they are strictly necessary or another type of cookie e.g. "functionality" or "performance" cookies. We also state in the table whether a cookie is a "persistent" or "session" cookie. The difference is that:
 - Persistent cookies remain on your device between browsing sessions. They are
 activated each time you visit the Website that created that particular cookie. For
 example, where a "persistent cookie" is used on a website to remember your
 log-in details, you will not need to enter those details each time you visit that
 website.

- Session cookies allow Website operators to link the actions of a user during a browser session. A browser session starts when you open the browser window and finishes when you close the browser window. Session cookies are created temporarily. Once you close the browser, all session cookies are deleted.
- 3.2. Some of our cookies are session cookies and will expire at the end of the browser session. However, if your browser is not closed for any reason, all our cookies will expire after 2 years.
- 3.3. Some of the cookies listed below are those set by our own Website when you visit. However, we also have cookies on our Website that are set by third parties. For example, in order to display targeted advertising to web visitors across a broad range of their own and other websites (for more information about how YouTube, Google, LinkedIn and WooCommerce use cookies and what information they collect, visit the third party website).
- 3.4. Strictly necessary cookies
- 3.4.1. Strictly necessary cookies are essential to enable you to receive a service on a website. For example, cookies to operate online shopping baskets, do your internet banking or to comply with the law (e.g. such as to keep your information safe).
